**SUBJECT:** FY 2017 ABTPA Grant Application

**Details:**

Please review the attached FY 2017 Texas Automobile Burglary Theft Prevention Authority grant application. The San Antonio Police Department is seeking grant funds not to exceed \$865,211 from the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority (ABTPA) to combat vehicle crimes in the surrounding area. This amount requested has already been approved by ABTPA as they have agreed to extend all current grants for FY2017 in the same amount that was awarded in FY2016. Upon approval and signature of the Chief, I will begin the RFCA process. Our goal is to make the April 21 City Council meeting. There will be no application process for this years grant. We must submit an approved budget to ABTPA by May 2.

The grant proposal is requesting continued funding for the current ABTPA grant. The ReACT grant project continues the Police Department's efforts at combating auto theft crimes. ReACT is a multi-jurisdictional unit composed of City and County elements. The San Antonio Police Department Vehicle Crimes Unit will work as part of the task force, and its General Fund budget will contribute to the in-kind portion of the grant.
