1. The undersigned is authorized to approve an exemption.
2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:  
Under the Collective Bargaining Agreement, the Labor Relations Committee (LRC) must approve all purchases of Police equipment. The LRC has approved the purchase of the Taser X26. The purchase of duty cartridges and batteries are needed to replace and or restore the tasers back into service. The 15' training cartridges are needed to recertify officers annually. Therefore, the San Antonio Police Department would like to purchase the LRC approved batteries and cartridges.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with GT Distributors which will cost approximately \$ \$525,000.00
