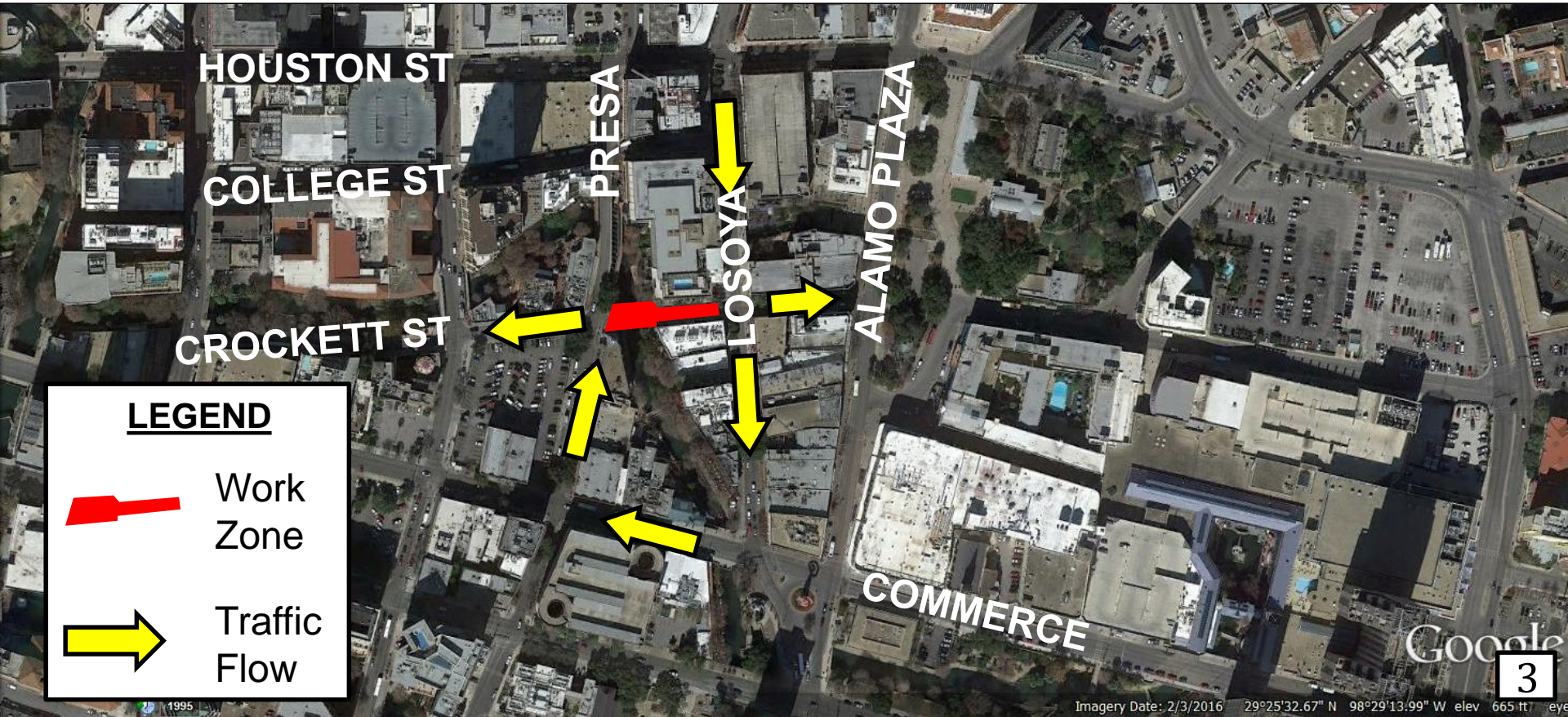


# Street Level







# Detour Map



**LEGEND**

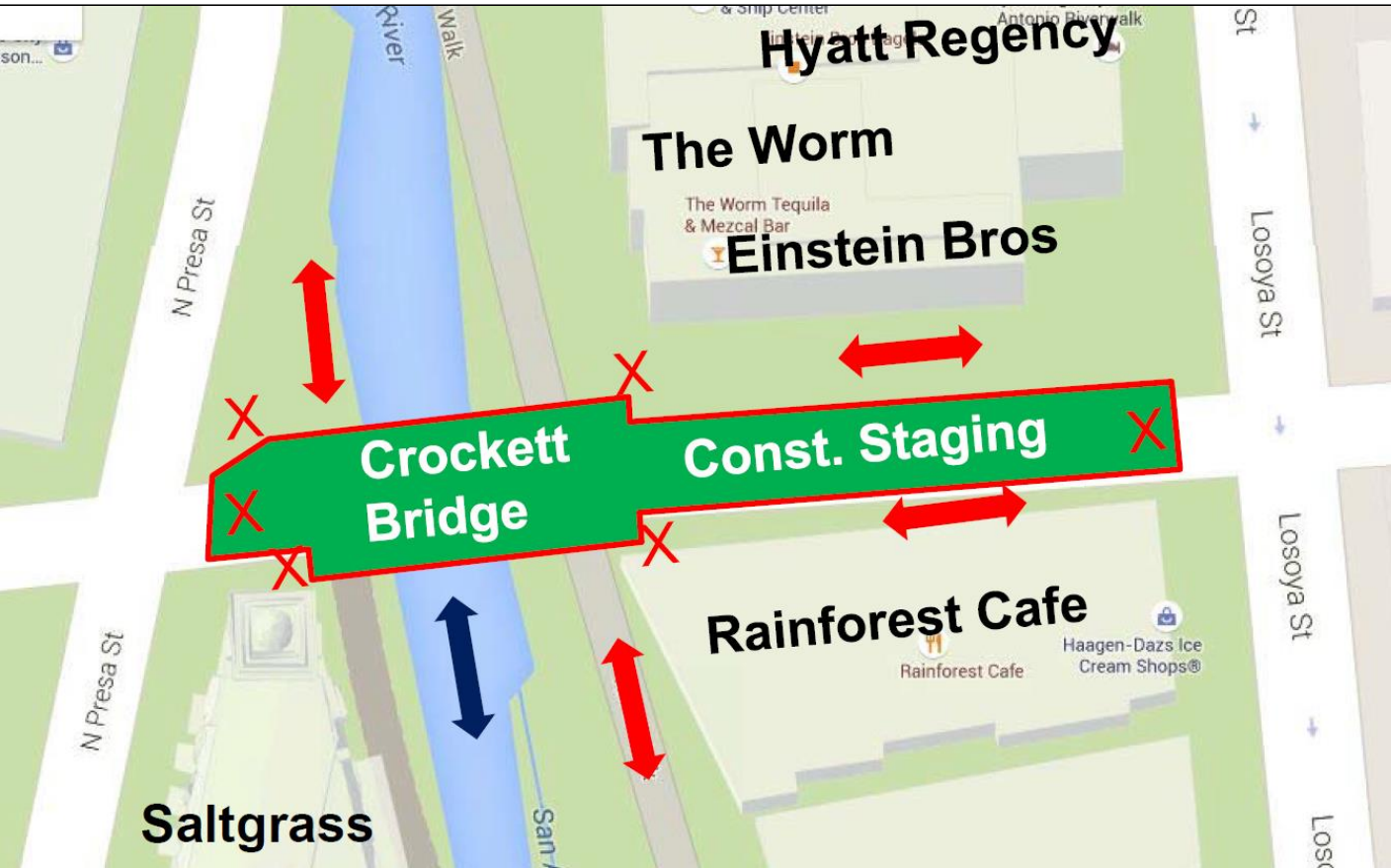
 Work Zone

# Controlling Dust and Debris

- Contractor to provide a netting type system to protect pedestrians and barges from falling debris
- Contractor is required to submit their system to the City for approval

# Project Benefits

- Crockett Bridge Restored to Full Load Capacity – No More Load Restrictions
- Increase safety of vehicles, barges, and pedestrians
- Provide drain inlet to reduce future corrosion on existing bridge members
- New roadway section
- Enhance appearance with illumination and landscaping

- June 2017 – Construction complete
