APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$250,000.00 FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN ACQUISITION WORKSTATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND FIREARMS NATIONAL INTEGRATED BALLISTIC INFORMATION NETWORK PROGRAM

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WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor (OOG), Criminal Justice Division (CJD) has funds in an amount up to \$250,000.00 available for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant for purchase of an acquisition workstation for participation in the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms National Integrated Ballistic Information Network Program, to assist the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) in firearms related investigations; and

WHEREAS, the program mission is to reduce firearms violence by acting in concert with Federal, State, tribal and local law enforcement to compare images of ballistic evidence obtained from crime scenes and firearms, and

WHEREAS, SAPD submitted the grant application on June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, this grant does not require an in-kind or cash match; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The grant application is hereby approved, and the Chief of Police for the City of San Antonio is hereby authorized to apply for, accept, reject, and alter grant funds in the amount up to \$250,000.00 from the OOG, CJD for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant for purchase of an additional Brass TRAX acquisition workstation to expand SAPD's participation in the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms National Integrated Ballistic Information Network Program, and terminate the grant on behalf of the city.


SECTION 2. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of funds under this grant, the City Council will return all grant funds to the OOG, CJD.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, new funds and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amount will be appropriated from the OOG. A final budget, which will include SAP Internal Orders and SAP GL Accounts, will be submitted by the SAPD upon award.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


