AN ORDINANCE

**APPROVING A PRE-QUALIFIED LIST OF PUBLIC ARTISTS WHOSE
SERVICES MAY BE USED TO IMPLEMENT PROJECTS INCLUDED
IN THE PUBLIC ART PLAN; AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS FOR
SUCH PROJECTS IN AN AMOUNTS NOT-TO-EXCEED THE
ELIGIBLE ALLOCATIONS; AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENTS
SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.**

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WHEREAS, the Department for Culture and Creative Development advertised a Call for Artists as part of an annual process to update the City’s pre-qualified artist list, which contains artist whose services may be used to implement projects included in the City’s public art plan (“Projects”), and 156 artist submittals were reviewed and scored by a selection panel; and

WHEREAS, the panel recommended 36 artists for inclusion in the list and the Public Art Board approved this recommendation at its February 19, 2014 meeting; and

WHEREAS, inclusion in this proposed pre-qualified roster does not guarantee a contracting opportunity; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. City Council approves the pre-qualified list of artists and authorizes contracts for services in amounts not to exceed the eligible allocations with artists from the list who are selected to implement the Projects. A copy of the list is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit I.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute agreements with artists from the list selected to implement the Projects in amounts not-to-exceed the eligible funding. The template agreements attached to this Ordinance as Exhibits II, III and IV shall be utilized to contract with artists for such services, as appropriate.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective ten days after its passage.
