

ORDINANCE 2021-04-01-0215

**AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF LINE-OF-DUTY INJURY LEAVE
FOR SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT FIRE CAPTAIN EDWARD
GUERRA JR.**

WHEREAS, section 143.073 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a firefighter injured in the line of duty is entitled to line-of-duty injury leave with full pay for a period commensurate with the injury and not to exceed one year; and

WHEREAS, section 143.073 also provides that a municipality's governing body may extend the line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year; and

WHEREAS, San Antonio Fire Department Fire Captain Edward Guerra Jr. was injured in the line of duty on January 11, 2013, and, as a result, required leave in excess of one year to address said injury; and

WHEREAS, Fire Captain Guerra is requesting an extension of line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year for the period January 16, 2014, to February 9, 2014; and


WHEREAS, approving the requested extension will restore 192 hours of accrued leave to Fire Captain Guerra; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. An extension beyond one year of San Antonio Fire Department Fire Captain Guerra's line-of-duty injury leave for the period January 16, 2014 to February 9, 2014 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
