

AN ORDINANCE **2017-04-06-0203**

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A CHILD CARE SERVICES (CCS) GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$46,242,717.00, FOR THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2017 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2018, TO WORKFORCE SOLUTIONS ALAMO FOR THE PURPOSE OF MANAGING THE CCS PROGRAM IN THE 13 COUNTY ALAMO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AREA.**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) administers the State's subsidized childcare program through funding received from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Child Care Development Block Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, TWC determines the allocation for childcare services based on federal appropriations and local needs and contracts with Workforce Solutions Alamo (WSA), the local workforce development board, to implement the program services; and

**WHEREAS**, in turn, WSA contracts with local agencies to provide program services; and

**WHEREAS**, for over 24 years, the Department of Human Services has managed the Child Care Services (CCS) program in the 12 county Alamo Workforce Development Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the program provides subsidized childcare for families meeting income and other qualification requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, in Fiscal Year 2016, the CCS program served an average of 9,466 children on a daily basis, with over 4,000 children on a waitlist to receive subsidized childcare, through 645 child care vendors/contractors; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2017, WSA issued the Request for Proposals for Fiscal Year 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, as of July 1, 2017, McMullen County will be added to the Alamo Workforce Development Area for an increase to 13 total Counties; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant application is due to WSA on April 12, 2017; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The submission of a grant application for an amount up to \$46,242,717.00 from Workforce Solutions Alamo for the FY 2018 Child Care Services program for the period October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018 is hereby approved. If awarded, the grant requires an in-kind match up to \$3,665,255.00 and \$40,000.00 in program income, provided by the City of San Antonio, which are also authorized. Acceptance and appropriation of funds, including approval of


a program budget and personnel complement, will be addressed upon award in subsequent ordinances. A copy of the grant application is on file with DHS.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Human Services (DHS) or her designee, is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said grant application submission.


**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


