AN ORDINANCE

RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS UPON AWARD IN AN AMOUNT TOTALING \$559,514.00 FROM THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION, FOR THE IMMUNIZATION AND VACCINES FOR CHILDREN GRANT BRINGING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE GRANT TO \$2,960,123.00 FOR THE ONGOING IMMUNIZATION PROJECT OF THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT AND EXTENDING THE GRANT TERM THROUGH MARCH 31, 2017.

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WHEREAS, in collaboration with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) administers an Immunization Project (Project) that works to reduce illnesses by maximizing the number of children immunized against vaccine-preventable diseases such as measles, rubella, mumps, diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, polio, Haemophilus influenza type b, varicella, pneumonia, hepatitis A & B, rotavirus, human papillomavirus (HPV), influenza, and meningitis; and

WHEREAS, the Project has two components, the Vaccines for Children Program (VFC Program) and the 317 Childhood Immunization Program (Section 317 Program); and

WHEREAS, the VFC Program provides vaccines recommended by the CDC and the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) to over 175 VFC-enrolled healthcare providers in San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, this program targets children who are eligible for Medicaid and those who are either uninsured or underinsured (i.e. child's insurance does not cover immunizations); and

WHEREAS, the Section 317 Program provides supplemental vaccines targeted to children seen in VFC provider and Metro Health clinic settings who are not eligible for VFC vaccines; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the grant provides support for project personnel and infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Metro Health is requesting Council ratify the submission of a grant application and authorize the acceptance of additional funds in an amount up to \$559,514.00 from the CDC to continue the Immunization and Vaccines for Children Program bringing the total amount of the grant to \$2,960,123.00 for a term beginning January 1, 2016 and ending March 31, 2017; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The submission of a grant application to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for additional funds is hereby ratified. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or his designee is authorized to 1) accept additional funds upon award in an amount totaling \$559,514.00 for the Immunization and Vaccines for Children Grant bringing the total amount of the grant to \$2,960,123.00 for the ongoing Immunization Project of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District and 2) extend the grant term through March 31, 2017. A copy of said application which is incorporated herein for all purposes is on file with the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or his designee is further authorized to initiate, negotiate, and execute any and all necessary documents and a grant contract to effectuate the application and acceptance of the referenced grant funds, and to execute contract amendments pertaining to this grant contract, to include: a) carry-over funds, when ascertained and approved by the funding agency through a revised notice of award; b) line item budget revisions authorized by the funding agency; c) modifications to the performance measures authorized by the funding agency and listed in the contract so long as the terms of the amendment stay within the general parameters of the intent of the grant; d) no cost extensions; and e) amendments which will provide supplemental grant funds to the grant by the funding agency in an amount up to 20% of the total amount awarded to the grant to include the funds awarded under this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Should funding be awarded, Fund 26022000 entitled "Dept Of Health & Human Services" is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant funding, and the sum of \$559,514.00 from the CDC will be appropriated in said fund. The proposed revised budget attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I** is approved. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
