

AN ORDINANCE 2015-11-19-0960

ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID AND AWARDING A TASK ORDER CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO J3 COMPANY, LLC IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,698,962.00 FOR THE 2016-2017 TASK ORDER CONTRACT FOR STORM WATER PROJECTS LOCATED THROUGHOUT THE CITY.

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WHEREAS, Task Order Contracts are used for small construction projects to allow for quick execution of work and as part of the department’s continuing efforts to improve efficiency, the Transportation & Capital Improvements Department will utilize the services under this agreement to expedite project delivery and completion; and

WHEREAS, Task Order Contracts are advertised with an estimated quantity of work and unit prices are set by the bidding contractor for the duration of the contract; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by **J3 Company LLC**, for an amount not to exceed \$4,698,962.00 for the construction of storm water projects located throughout the City; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of **J3 Company LLC** in the amount not to exceed \$4,698,962.00 for the construction of various projects that have received federal funding, located throughout the City is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. A Task Order construction contract is hereby awarded to **J3 Company LLC**.

SECTION 3. The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funding for this Ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.
- b) Payment not to exceed \$4,698,962.00 per annual contract is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to **J3 Company, LLC**, for the construction of storm water projects throughout the City.


SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
