

AN ORDINANCE 2014 - 09 - 04 - 0653

**AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$33,302.00 FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR THE COLUMN CASE MANAGEMENT PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD), has awarded grant funds in an amount up to \$33,302.00 to support the San Antonio Police Department's Column Case Management Project; and

**WHEREAS**, said project will establish a streamlined case management workflow system that will be integrated with the department's Automated Field Reporting and Record Management System; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant period is October 1, 2014, to September 30, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, no cash or in-kind matching contributions are required; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$33,302.00 from the CJD to support the San Antonio Police Department's Column Case Management Project. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of San Antonio to accept said grant. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the CJD funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the CJD in full. The City Council designates the assistant chief of police as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**SECTION 3.** Fund 26055000 (Criminal Justice Division) is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant. Should funding be awarded, the sum of \$33,302.00 from the CJD will be appropriated in said fund.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


