
This Certificate of Exemption is executed and filed with the Purchasing Department as follows:

1. The undersigned is authorized to approve an exemption.
2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

SAFD requires an annual contract for supplies / equipment for Zoll X Series 12 Lead Monitors which provide advanced cardio Monitoring to save lives and protect the health and safety of the City's residents. SAFD requires a full supply contract to be in place prior to deployment of the new X Series 12 Lead Monitors. This is a very time sensitive item and will coincide with training and the issuance of these monitors. This procurement will be made utilizing a Public Health & Safety Exemption for brand exclusivity. These supplies includes disposable blood pressure cuffs, ( all sizes) CO monitoring tube and clips, and 12 lead wires for lead placement.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with Zoll Medical Corp & Bound Tree Medical which will cost approximately \$ \$781,000.00.
