A RESOLUTION

OF NO OBJECTION TO THE APPLICANT’S REQUEST FOR CITY COUNCIL SUPPORT TOWARD THEIR 9% LOW INCOME HOUSING TAX CREDIT APPLICATION SUBMITTED TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR THE ECKHERT VILLAGE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Eckhert Village, Ltd. (the “Applicant”) has proposed a 80 unit affordable housing development located at the NE corner of Bandera Road and Eckert Road in Council District 7 named Eckhert Village, in the City of San Antonio, Texas, County of Bexar; and

WHEREAS, Applicant has advised that it intends to submit an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) for 2014 Competitive 9% Housing Tax Credits for Eckhert Village; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. It is hereby confirmed that the City has no objection to the proposed Eckhert Village project located at the NE corner of Bandera Road and Eckert Road in the City of San Antonio, Texas, and that this formal action has been taken to put on record the opinion expressed by the City of San Antonio on March 20, 2014.

SECTION 2. That for and on behalf of City Council, the City Clerk is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to certify this resolution to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
