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This Certificate of Exemption is executed and filed with the Purchasing Department as follows:

1. The undersigned is authorized to approve an exemption.
2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

The two units will require removing and replacing the vehicle cab or repairing the vehicle Cab and repairing major collision damage on the vehicle. This is a procurement necessary because of unforeseen damage to the vehicle. Both vehicles suffered major damage the current annual contract for medium & heavy duty truck collision repair contractors facility is not equipped to repair vehicle damages this server. The repairs are beyond the abilities of a small body shop to repair due to large truck equipment required to repair these vehicles.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with a Request For Offer (RFO) to Collision Country Repair Center with intent of to award the Solid Waste Refuse Trucks unit numbers 4152 and 468313 with an option A and B, to repair each vehicle removing and replacing the vehicle cab or repairing the vehicle Cab and repairing major collision damage on the vehicle which will cost approximately \$ \$103,701.16.
