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STATEMENT OF WORK

Statement of Work

Work shall include: Davila Construction shall supply all labor, material, insurance, and bonding to fabricate and install new signs as per plans and specifications.

Mobilization and Disassembly

- Provide all necessary equipment.
- Provide necessary barricades for traffic and pedestrian traffic control.
- Call in for all dig tests prior to coring holes.
- Clean up of jobsite will be done daily.
- Final clean will be provided at substantial completion of project.

Sign Work

- Provide and install all new signs as per plans and specifications.
- Bring in all traffic control barricades as need per site.
- Prep right of way area as needed for sign installation.
- Provide 24" drill shaft for signs.
- All signs legs are to be set in concrete after hole is drilled.
- Provide and install (18) eighteen signs as per plans and specifications.
- Clean up each site as needed after completion of sign installation.
- Provide and install concrete curb as needed as per plans and specifications.



Project time frame will be 8-10 weeks after receipt of approved shop drawings and submittals for fabrication. Once fabrication is complete installation would be about 5-6 weeks.

Exclusion

- Coordination with property owners to access each sign location.
- All signs and post are to be TxDOT standards (i.e. extruded aluminum signs and unpainted I-beam post). We have made no allowance for custom type signage designs shown in the plans. We have ignored custom signage designs in favor of usual TxDOT standards.
- No sign removal.
- Engineering.
- Any special inspections and or testing.
- Landscaping.
- All excess spoils will be spread out at job site.

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
