**WHEREAS**, the Texas legislature is considering legislation to establish an Alamo preservation fund; and

**WHEREAS**, a motion was made by City Councilman Treviño to support this legislation related to the Alamo and it was approved following a vote of the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council now wishes to amend the City's 84<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session to support any legislation that creates an Alamo Preservation Fund; **NOW THEREFORE:**


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City of San Antonio City Council hereby supports legislation related to the creation of an Alamo Preservation Fund.

**SECTION 2.** Staff is directed to inform the Bexar County Legislative Delegation of the Program and is authorized to undertake such steps as are reasonably necessary to accomplish the City's various initiatives during the 84<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes.

**PASSED AND APPROVED** this 2nd day of April, 2015.


