ORDINANCE

**APPROVING AN INCREASE TO THE SBA TOWER LEASE
AGREEMENTS FOR THE SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC SAFETY RADIO
SYSTEM.**

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WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio manages SBA tower lease agreements in support of the Alamo Area Regional Radio System (“AARRS”) used by City of San Antonio (“City”) Police and Fire Departments, CPS Energy, Bexar County (“County”) and surrounding participating agencies; and

WHEREAS, On February 15, 2018, Council approved a contract for the construction, system delivery, and system operation of a new P25 compliant public safety radio system, referred to as the Alamo Area Regional Radio System (“AARRS”). On the same date, Council also authorized the execution of an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the City, Bexar County (County), and CPS Energy (CPS) for County and CPS to make financial contributions to obtain minority ownership interests in the AARRS; and

WHEREAS, On June 13, 2019 Council approved Ordinance 2019-06-13-0518 that authorized lease agreements in support of the new P25 radio system which included the SBA lease for San Geronimo Tower Site. The lease agreement also supports this location during a transition period starting April 1, 2019 then ending January 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the increase to the lease rate of \$7,208.97 is due to the increase in microwave dish size from 4 feet to 6 feet. The increase cost for this adjustment will be shared by the entities based on the Interlocal Agreement approved by the City, CPS Energy and Bexar County; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the ITSD Department or designee, is authorized to execute an amendment to the SBA lease for San Geronimo Tower Site in support of the AARRS. A copy of the amended agreement, in final form, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
