High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Grant Program

- Grant Period: January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2021
- Total Budget: \$2,136,824.00
- No Cash Match
- Ordinance authorizes submission and acceptance up to \$2,136,824.00 from ONDCP Agency plus additional grant award modifications up to 20%

HIDTA

- 27th year that ONDCP has offered SAPD this grant
 - HIDTA 2018 – Initial Budget of \$1,988,146 plus additional modifications of \$185,535 granted with overall Budget \$2,173,681 in 2018.
 - HIDTA 2019 –Initial Budget of \$2,136,824.00 plus additional modifications of \$53,627 granted with overall Budget \$2,190,451 in 2019
- **Mission:** to reduce drug trafficking in the San Antonio metropolitan area by instituting innovative narcotic enforcement investigations and seizing illegally obtained assets in an effort to reduce the profitability
