AN ORDINANCE 2014 - 09 - 18 - 0714

AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO BY AMENDING CHAPTER 35, UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE, SECTION 35-304, OF THE CITY CODE OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS BY CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY OF CERTAIN PROPERTY.

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WHEREAS, a public hearing was held after notice and publication regarding this amendment to the Official Zoning Map at which time parties in interest and citizens were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Commission has submitted a final report to the City Council regarding this amendment to the Official Zoning Map of the City of San Antonio; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 35, Unified Development Code, Section 35-304, Official Zoning Map, of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is amended by changing the zoning district boundary of Lot 15, Block 1, NCB 14164 from "IDZ RIO-2 AHOD" Infill Development Zone River Improvement Overlay-2 Airport Hazard Overlay District with uses permitted in "C-3" General Commercial District, "MF-50" Multi-Family District, "D" Downtown District, and the following additional uses: beverage manufacture or microbrewery (alcohol or non-alcohol) and water distillation, purification and bottling; fabrication and manufacturing of artisan goods and products including furniture, cabinetry, wood products, metalwork and metal products, bread, candy and other food products, leather products, clothing, glass and tile; and the fabrication and manufacturing of prototypes developed or conceived by any college, university, trade school, institute or other educational facility located on the property to "IDZ HL RIO-2 AHOD" Historic Landmark Infill Development Zone River Improvement Overlay-2 Airport Hazard Overlay District with uses permitted in "C-3" General Commercial District, "MF-50" Multi-Family District, "D" Downtown District, and the following additional uses: beverage manufacture or microbrewery (alcohol or non-alcohol) and water distillation, purification and bottling; fabrication and manufacturing of artisan goods and products including furniture, cabinetry, wood products, metalwork and metal products, bread, candy and other food products, leather products, clothing, glass and tile; and the fabrication and manufacturing of prototypes developed or conceived by any college, university, trade school, institute or other educational facility located on the property.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of Chapter 35 except those expressly amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect including the penalties for violations as made and provided for in Section 35-491.

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SECTION 3. The Director of Development Services shall change the zoning records and maps in accordance with this ordinance and the same shall be available and open to the public for inspection.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective September 28, 2014.
