3. Notice and appropriate action to approve the announcement for the Police Sergeant examination. This two (2) hour written examination will be given at 9:00 AM on Monday, November 13, 2017, at the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center, 900 East Market Street, Hemisfair Ballroom. The eligibility list resulting from this exam will remain in existence for one (1) year after the date on which the written examination was given or until the list is exhausted.

4. Notice and appropriate action regarding the approval to administer a Probationary Firefighter Examination. The two hour written examination will be given at 9:00 AM on Friday, June 30, 2017, at the Fire Training Academy, 300 S. Callaghan Rd, San Antonio, Texas 78227. The eligibility list will be valid for a period of one year from the date of approval or until the list has been exhausted.

5. Notice and appropriate action regarding the approval to administer a Fire Engineer Examination. The two-hour written examination will be given at 9:00 AM on Tuesday, July 18, 2017, at the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center, 900 East Market, Room 221. The eligibility list resulting from this exam will remain in existence for one (1) year beginning on the first day of the month following the month the written examination was given or until the list is exhausted.

6. Notice and appropriate action regarding the approval of the eligibility list for the position of Police Captain created from Police Captain Examination administered in two parts on March 30, 2017 and April 18, 2017. This eligibility list will be valid for 18 months from the date of certification by the Commission.
