The City Council of San Antonio will convene in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Plaza Building, 105 Main Plaza, San Antonio, Texas 78205 no earlier than 9:00 A.M. Thursday, August 31, 2017 for the following purposes:

**31.** <u>17-4958</u> An Ordinance extending the local state of disaster and authorizing the City Manager to take such actions and spend such identifiable funds as may be necessary to provide emergency relief to those impacted by Hurricane Harvey and take all necessary actions to seek reimbursement for all expenditures from local, state, and federal sources. [Erik Walsh, Deputy City Manager; Lawrence Trevino, Deputy Chief; Office of Emergency Management]

This ordinance will be considered on an emergency basis, with two hours posted notice under the requirements of section 551.045 of the Texas Open Meetings Act, on the ground that an emergency and urgent public necessity exists. Hurricane Harvey landed on the Texas Gulf Coast on August 25th, 2017, and Gulf Coast residents are evacuating. Many have arrived and continue to arrive in San Antonio for refuge and need immediate assistance in response to the growing crisis. Public Safety crews have been deployed to assist the Gulf Coast communities.

At any time during the meeting, City Council may hold an executive session under Section 551.071 for attorney consultation to discuss legal issues relating to utilizing city facilities in connection with the provision of emergency relief to individuals impacted by Hurricane Harvey.
