1. Protest and appeals of questions from the written examination for the position of Police Sergeant administered on November 13, 2017.
2. Pending the outcome of the Police Sergeant Appeals Hearing, notice and appropriate action regarding the approval of the eligibility list for the position of Police Sergeant created from Police Sergeant Examination administered on November 13, 2017. This eligibility list will be valid for a period of one (1) year after the date on which the written examination was given or until the list is exhausted. If changes are made to the examination as a result of the Appeals Hearing, this item will be tabled and an amended eligibility list will be certified at a subsequent San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission Meeting.

3. Notice of SAPD disciplinary suspensions without pay:

- a. An indefinite suspension for Fire Lieutenant Abel Gomez effective October 25, 2017. A release and settlement agreement was signed on October 25, 2017 reducing the suspension to ninety (90) day suspension.
- b. An agreed three (3) day suspension for Officer Jack E. Harper III effective October 25, 2017.
- c. A temporary suspension for Fire Engineer Emilio Montes effective November 9, 2017.
- d. An agreed two (2) day suspension for Officer Mathew E. Nowak effective November 9, 2017.
- e. An agreed three (3) day suspension for Officer Jason Hernandez effective November 9, 2017.
- f. A one (1) day suspension for Probationary Officer Richard H. Neil Jr. effective November 13, 2017.

These matters have not been appealed and are, therefore, final.

- g. An indefinite suspension for Detective Kenneth Valdez effective November 2, 2017. A letter of appeal was received November 6, 2017.
