These comments will be read at the time the agenda item is heard, as requested. Please include your full name, home or work address, and item number (if applicable). General comments unrelated to specific items will be read during the Public Comments section of the agenda.

2. Drop off or mail a written statement to the Parks and Recreation Department Directors Office by 12:00 PM on Monday, October 26, 2020. Comments may also be hand delivered to the Parks and Recreation Director's Office at 114 West Commerce Street, attention Ryan Evans. The written statement may be up to 300 words. Please include your full name, home or work address and item number. These comments will be read at the time the item is heard or during the general Public Comments section of the agenda.

3. Leave a voice mail message of a maximum of two (2) minutes by dialing (210) 207-6101 by 12:00PM on Monday, October 26, 2020. Your message will be played during the meeting. Please include your full name, home or work address, and item number (if applicable).

4. Sign up to give your comments live during the meeting by leaving your name, telephone number, and item number on which you would like to speak on at (210) 207-6101 by Monday, October 16 at 12:00pm. City staff will contact you when your item is up for discussion but cannot guarantee a specific time after 6:00 PM. Once you join the call, you will be given two (2) minutes to provide your comments.
