General comments unrelated to specific items will be read during the Public Comments section of the agenda.
2. Drop off or mail a written statement to the Parks and Recreation Department Directors Office located at 114 W. Commerce St. in the Municipal Plaza Building by 4:00 p.m. on February 22, 2021. The written statement may be up to 300 words. Please include your full name, home or work address and item number. These comments will be read at the time the item is heard or during the general Public Comments section of the agenda.

3. Leave a voice mail message of a maximum of two (2) minutes by dialing (210) 207-4239 by 4:00 p.m. on February 22, 2021. Your message will be played during the meeting. Please include your full name, home or work address, and item number (if applicable).

4. Sign up to give your comments live during the meeting by leaving your name, telephone number, and item number on which you would like to speak on at (210) 207-4239 by 4:00 p.m. on February 22, 2021. City staff will contact you when your item is up for discussion but cannot guarantee a specific time after 5:30 p.m.. Once you join the call, you will be given two (2) minutes to provide your comments.
