AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF PRINT MEDIA ADVERTISING WITH CLEAR CHANNEL OUTDOOR FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$55,131.00 TO SUPPORT SAN **ANTONIO METROPOLITAN DISTRICT** IN **PROMOTING CHILDREN'S** ORAL HEALTH SERVICES, HIV AND SYPHILIS PREVENTION, AND BREASTFEEDING PROMOTION BY EDUCATING THE COMMUNITY AND PROVIDING OUTREACH, FUNDED BY THE MEDICAID 1115 WAIVER PROGRAM PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED BY CITY COUNCIL. SECTION 1. The offer submitted by Clear Channel Outdoor to provide the City of San Antonio Metropolitan Health District with print media advertising for a cost not to exceed \$55,131.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the bid tabulation and contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$55,131.00 for this ordinance is available for Fund 29658000, Internal Order 836000000014 and General Ledger 5203040, as part of the Fiscal Year 2014 Budget. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Clear Channel Outdoor and should be encumbered with a purchase order.
