AN ORDINANCE

**ACCEPTING THE OFFER FROM FUQUAY, INC. TO PERFORM
REPAIRS TO THE JAPANESE TEA GARDEN POND UNDERGROUND
PUMP EQUIPMENT FOR AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$600,000.00,
FUNDED FROM THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADOPTED
GENERAL OPERATING BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Fuquay, Inc., through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (a.k.a. the “Buyboard”), to provide the City with repairs to the Japanese Tea Garden pond underground pump equipment for an estimated cost of \$600,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 97097 on January 30, 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Fuquay, Inc. to provide the City with repairs to the Japanese Tea Garden pond underground pump equipment for an estimated cost of \$600,000.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.
