AUTHORIZING THE NAMING OF THE TENNIS COURTS AT WOODLAWN LAKE PARK, LOCATED IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 7, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, AS THE JOE V. ALDERETE, JR. TENNIS COURTS.

WHEREAS, Councilman Chris Media initiated the naming of the tennis courts at Woodlawn Lake Park in Council District 7 as the Joe V. Alderete, Jr. Tennis Courts by submitting a memo to commemorate and recognize the long-time civic leader for his invaluable contributions to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department staff was tasked with implementing this request and followed the facility naming process identified in Chapter 6 of the City Code by creating a committee charged with making a recommendation on the request, providing required notice, and setting and conducting a public hearing on March 18, 2014; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the evidence including written support and opposition to the naming and public testimony, the committee approved a motion recommending the tennis courts as Woodlawn Lake Park be named after Joe V. Alderete, Jr. NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The tennis courts located in Woodlawn Lake Park in City Council District 7 are hereby named Joe V. Alderete, Jr. Tennis Courts.

SECTION 2. There is no financial impact as a result of passing this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it becomes effective ten days after passage.
