**AUTHORIZING THE NAMING OF THE TENNIS COURTS AT  
WOODLAWN LAKE PARK, LOCATED IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT  
7, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, AS THE JOE V. ALDERETE, JR. TENNIS  
COURTS.**

**WHEREAS**, Councilman Chris Media initiated the naming of the tennis courts at Woodlawn Lake Park in Council District 7 as the Joe V. Alderete, Jr. Tennis Courts by submitting a memo to commemorate and recognize the long-time civic leader for his invaluable contributions to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parks and Recreation Department staff was tasked with implementing this request and followed the facility naming process identified in Chapter 6 of the City Code by creating a committee charged with making a recommendation on the request, providing required notice, and setting and conducting a public hearing on March 18, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, after reviewing the evidence including written support and opposition to the naming and public testimony, the committee approved a motion recommending the tennis courts as Woodlawn Lake Park be named after Joe V. Alderete, Jr. **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The tennis courts located in Woodlawn Lake Park in City Council District 7 are hereby named Joe V. Alderete, Jr. Tennis Courts.

**SECTION 2.** There is no financial impact as a result of passing this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance becomes effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it becomes effective ten days after passage.
