CONFIRMING THE EXCLUSION OF PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE TRAFFIC COUNTS FROM TRAFFIC IMPACT ANALYSIS STUDIES

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio currently does not include pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts in its Traffic Impact Analysis; and

WHEREAS, consideration is being taken whether or not pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts should be included in these Traffic Impact Analysis; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that to include pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts as a part of the Traffic Impact Analysis would require a Multi-Modal Level Of Service (MMLOS) to be performed which would incur additional costs and would also require an amendment to the Unified Development Code; and

WHEREAS, it was further determined that including pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts as a part of the Traffic Impact Analysis would not be needed, given that providing pedestrian and bicycle facilities are already a requirement of the Unified Development Code; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is a confirmation of the exclusion of pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts from the Traffic Impact Analysis studies; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The exclusion of Pedestrian and Bicycle Traffic Counts from the Traffic Impact Analysis studies is hereby confirmed.

SECTION 2. There is no fiscal impact associated with this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.
