

A RESOLUTION **2014-05-29-0019R**

**CONFIRMING THE EXCLUSION OF PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE TRAFFIC  
COUNTS FROM TRAFFIC IMPACT ANALYSIS STUDIES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Antonio currently does not include pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts in its Traffic Impact Analysis; and

**WHEREAS**, consideration is being taken whether or not pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts should be included in these Traffic Impact Analysis; and

**WHEREAS**, it was determined that to include pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts as a part of the Traffic Impact Analysis would require a Multi-Modal Level Of Service (MMLOS) to be performed which would incur additional costs and would also require an amendment to the Unified Development Code; and

**WHEREAS**, it was further determined that including pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts as a part of the Traffic Impact Analysis would not be needed, given that providing pedestrian and bicycle facilities are already a requirement of the Unified Development Code; and

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution is a confirmation of the exclusion of pedestrian and bicycle traffic counts from the Traffic Impact Analysis studies; **NOW, THEREFORE**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The exclusion of Pedestrian and Bicycle Traffic Counts from the Traffic Impact Analysis studies is hereby confirmed.


**SECTION 2.** There is no fiscal impact associated with this Resolution.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.


