The committee recommends that we continue to purchase the Midwest Gloves, Item # 688-S, 688-M, 688-L, and 688-XL, that we are currently using. We feel that these gloves provide a higher level of protection from sharp or jagged edges due to the thicker material used by the manufacturer.
