## AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO AN AGREEMENT WITH PURDUE UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT WITH ADDITIONAL LEAN HEALTHCARE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH YELLOW BELT TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION COACHING IN A CUMULATIVE AMOUNT UP TO \$56,000.00 FOR A TERM BEGINNING AUGUST 1, 2013 AND ENDING ON JULY 31, 2015.

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) is an organization dedicated to providing leadership and services for San Antonio and Bexar County to prevent illness and injury, promote healthy behaviors, and protect against health hazards; and

WHEREAS, Metro Health is accomplishing its bold vision by moving toward a high-performance health department through innovative approaches to preventive care and population-based services; and

WHEREAS, in August 2013, Metro Health contracted with Purdue University to provide training to Metro Health Program Managers and Supervisors ("Program Managers") in the performance management system Lean Six Sigma for Public Health using the Purdue Healthcare Advisors Lean Healthcare for Public Health Yellow Belt curriculum; and

WHEREAS, through this training, Program Managers become eligible for Lean Six Sigma yellow belt certification after passing an exam and completing a project; and

**WHEREAS,** Purdue University is also providing remote coaching to project teams to facilitate the project work required for certification and to assess progress in implementing solutions, retention of key concepts and sustainability of strategies implemented; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract amendment will allow Metro Health to expand the training and certification coaching to 15 additional Program Managers; **NOW THEREFORE**:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) or his designee is authorized to execute an amendment to a Professional Services Agreement with Purdue University to provide Metro Health with additional Lean Healthcare for Public Health yellow belt training and certification coaching in a cumulative amount up to \$56,000.00 for a term beginning August 1, 2013 and ending on July 31, 2015. A copy of said amendment in substantially final form is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

**SECTION 2.** Fund 2602236044 entitled "Strengthening Public Health Infrastructure" and Internal Order 136000000612 are hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in authorization of this agreement.

**SECTION 3.** The sum of \$21,000.00 is hereby appropriated in the above designated fund and internal order. Payment is authorized to Purdue University in an amount up to \$56,000.00 upon issuance of a Purchase Order.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5**. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
