AN ORDINANCE

DESIGNATING THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS THE AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL AND PROVIDING SPECIFIC REQUIRED LANGUAGE IN CONNECTION WITH THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, TO SUPPORT THE CURE VIOLENCE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2014-05-15-0334 authorized the acceptance of grant funds from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD), to support the Cure Violence Project for the period March 1, 2014, to September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 2014-05-15-0334 to include specific language required by the Texas Administrative Code; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2014-05-15-0334 is hereby amended to include the provisions set out below.

SECTION 6. In the event of loss or misuse of the CJD funds, the grant funds shall be returned to the CJD in full.

SECTION 7. The Chief of Police is hereby designated as the grantee's authorized official.

SECTION 8. The authorized official is hereby given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
