## AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING  $\mathbf{AN}$ **INFLUENZA** REAGENT **RESOURCE AMERICAN** AGREEMENT WITH THE **TYPE CULTURE** COLLECTION TO **PROVIDE** THE SAN **ANTONIO** METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT'S BIOTERRORISM AND INFLUENZA SURVEILLANCE LAB WITH FREE REAGENTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH COMMUNITY **CENTERS DISEASE** CONTROL FROM THE **FOR** PREVENTION.

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**WHEREAS**, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) works year round to improve and enhance international influenza surveillance efforts and to build global laboratory capacity in preparation for a future pandemic; and

WHEREAS, in September 2008, CDC's Influenza Division contracted with the American Type Culture Collection (ATCC), a not-for-profit organization, to implement the Influenza Reagent Resource (IRR); and

**WHEREAS**, the IRR, funded by the CDC, is a biological reagent repository established to provide free access to influenza virus strains and research reagents; and

WHEREAS, the IRR resources are available to public health facilities, research institutions, life science companies and other entities, agencies and institutions; and

WHEREAS, reagents will be manufactured and distributed by the IRR to increase the availability and accessibility of influenza viruses and reagents for public health purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, this agreement will govern the transfer of research materials between the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District and the ATCC and the use of the research materials; **NOW THEREFORE**:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) or his designee is authorized to execute a Influenza Reagent Resource Agreement with the American Type Culture Collection to provide Metro Health's Bioterrorism and Influenza Surveillance Lab with free reagents for the benefit of the public health community from the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention. A copy of the agreement in substantially final form is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I.** 

**SECTION 2.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
