

AN ORDINANCE 2014 - 08 - 07 - 0 5 2 5

**AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND BEXAR COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$376,337.00 TO INCORPORATE THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES OF THE CITY'S "BRIARCREST DRAINAGE PROJECT" AND THE CITY'S "HIGGINS AND CLASSEN INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS" INTO THE COUNTY'S APPROVED FLOOD CONTROL CAPITAL PROJECT "KNOLL CREEK BETWEEN CLASSEN AND JUNG ROAD (SC-4)" LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 10.**

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**WHEREAS**, the Knoll Creek Project (SC-4) is part of the Bexar County Flood Control Program and is located within the City limits between Classen and Jung Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project will improve two low water crossings, provide access during the 100 year storm event and protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens, as well as, include some channelization upstream and downstream of the proposed drainage structures at Classen and Jung Road; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2011, during the preliminary design phase of the Knoll Creek Project (SC-4), Bexar County Flood Control Program acquired a total of 19 properties along Briarcrest and Classen at an estimated cost of \$3.5 million and in addition, Bexar County is providing an estimated \$4 million dollars for the design and construction of their portion of this project.

**WHEREAS**, under this Agreement, Bexar County's Knoll Creek Project (SC-4) will incorporate the design and construction of two City Projects, Briarcrest Drainage Project, a 2011 Stormwater Revenue Bond Project in the amount of \$182,646.00 and a portion of the Higgins and Classen Intersection Improvement Project, a 2012 Bond Program Project in the amount of \$193,691.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project will consist of adding pavement to Classen Road to accommodate left turning traffic from northbound Classen Road onto Briarcrest Drive and the Knoll Creek Project will consist of an underground drainage system designed to capture surface runoff upstream of Briarcrest Drive and convey runoff through the system into a drainage swale south of Briarcrest Drive to alleviate flooding along Briarcrest Drive; and

**WHEREAS**, by incorporating the design and construction of the two City projects into the County's approved Flood Control Capital Project Knoll Creek between Classen and Jung Road would prove to be cost effective and minimize construction inconveniences to the public; and

**WHEREAS**, following Substantial Completion of the three Projects (Briarcrest Drainage, Higgins Intersection Improvement Project and Knoll Creek, the City will be responsible for all costs associated with operating, maintaining, and repairing the Projects and County shall have no further financial obligation; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with Bexar County for City to fund the amount not-to-exceed \$193,691.00 for a portion of the Higgins and Classen Intersection Improvement Project and amount not to exceed \$182,646.00 for the Briarcrest Drive Culvert Addition Project into the design and construction of the County's approved Flood Control Capital Project Knoll Creek between Classen and Jung Road; and

**WHEREAS**, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of Council's policy to collaborate and coordinate with other governmental agencies in supporting the City's commitment to maintaining and improving existing infrastructure; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the City of San Antonio and Bexar County in an amount not to exceed \$376,337.00 to incorporate the design and construction management services of the City's "Briarcrest Drainage Project" and the City's "Higgins and Classen Intersection Improvements" into the County's approved Flood Control Capital Project "Knoll Creek Between Classen and Jung Road (SC-4)". The Contract must be executed by all parties within 90 days of signing of this Ordinance; otherwise, the contract must be considered through a subsequent Ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Payment in the amount not to exceed \$182,645.50 in SAP Fund 48099000, Municipal Drainage Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-01223, Briarcrest Drive Culvert Addition, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **Bexar County**, for design and construction services.
- b) Payment in the amount not to exceed \$193,691.50 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00306, Higgins Road & Classen Road Intersection, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **Bexar County**, for design and construction services.
- c) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds

Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
