I look forward to working with everyone on the important work facing our city. The attached document is an updated list of our City Council Committees, as well as Councilmember assignments to Boards and Commissions and as Liaisons.

There are two key revisions to the previous City Council Committee structure:

1. Creation of a new Comprehensive Planning Committee. With the update of our city's Comprehensive Master Plan as well as the development of a Comprehensive Transportation plan on the horizon, this committee will allow the City Council to provide direction for policy decisions that may impact San Antonio for years to come.

The Comprehensive Planning Committee (CPC) is responsible for establishing and overseeing a community-based process to guide the delivery and implementation of a Comprehensive Plan for the City of San Antonio. This process shall encompass citizen education, facilitate and rely on the development of citizen leaders, and foster collaboration with a broad range of stakeholder groups through creation of an advisory committee. The CPC is also charged with identifying existing or proposed COSA projects, plans or initiatives that shall be coordinated and aligned with the Comprehensive plan.

2. Assignment of education issues to the Economic and Community Development Committee. Education is a key economic development issue for our community. As such, the topic must be included in any economic development strategy. Ensuring that San Antonio has a pipeline of workers who are prepared for the jobs that can support a robust economy must be part of the work of the Economic and Community Development committee.
