#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Joint City/County Citizens Bond Oversight Commission is comprised of 20 members. The San Antonio

City Council and the Bexar County Commissioners Court each appoint 10 members to serve on the Commission. Appointments are made to ensure representation from all sectors of the City of San Antonio and Bexar County. Kenneth Thomas, Chair of the Commission was selected jointly by Mayor Castro and County Judge Wolff. Members will serve two-year terms.
