## Head Start Recruitment Events 2015-2016

City of San Antonio Head Start, grantee, has 2 Head Start program providers with a contact person for each program that is responsible for the applications received from families interested in applying for preschool services. Below is a listing of the 2 programs with general information.

Preschool children who qualify and are enrolled will receive comprehensive programming including services in the areas of dental, health, nutrition, mental health, education, disability and family support. Transportation is limited for children (see each provider for more details about availability). Children with disabilities, mild to severe, are encouraged to apply.

In order to be eligible for the Head Start preschool program, age and income guidelines are in place. The child must be 3 or 4 on or before September 1, and family income for a 12 month time period is evaluated at/below/or above 100% of DHHS poverty guidelines. Families may qualify as categorically eligible if the family is experiencing homelessness, receiving public assistance (SSI / TANF), or has a child in foster / kinship placement.
