WHEREAS, this contract will be awarded in compliance with the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Program, which requires contracts be reviewed by a Goal Setting Committee to establish a requirement and/or incentive unique to the particular contract in an effort to maximize the amount of small, minority, and women-owned business participation on the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Goal Setting Committee set a Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal of sixteen percent (16%) and an African American Enterprise (AABE) subcontracting goal of one percent (1%); and

WHEREAS, TCL Construction Enterprises, Inc. has committed to the Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal of sixteen percent (16%) and an African American Enterprise (AABE) subcontracting goal of one percent (1%) subcontractor participation; NOW THEREFORE:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive qualified bid in the amount of \$729,930.50, from TCL Construction Enterprises, Inc. for a labor and material contract for concrete work in San Antonio parks, providing labor and concrete material for park operations as needed and in accordance with the annual adopted budget approved by City Council, is hereby accepted. The contract described herein shall become effective upon the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates so long as such deposits are accomplished within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this ordinance. 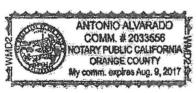
