WHEREAS, utilization of annual contracts allows the City to procure numerous different commodities in support of the normal daily operations; and

WHEREAS, the formal competitive bid was advertised in The Hart Beat on February 2, 2015, and February 9, 2015, on the City's website and in the Electronic State Business Daily; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on Tuesday, March 3, 2015, with five (5) bidders submitting their bid; and

WHEREAS, Friesenhahn Paving, LLC was the lowest responsive qualified bidder with a bid amount of \$1,058,480.00; and

WHEREAS, this contract will be awarded in compliance with the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Program, which requires contracts be reviewed by a Goal Setting Committee to establish a requirement and/or incentive unique to the particular contract in an effort to maximize the amount of small, minority, and women-owned business participation on the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Goal Setting Committee set a Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal of 15% and an African American Business Enterprise (AABE) subcontracting goal of 1%; and

WHEREAS, Friesenhahn Paving has committed to 15% M/WBE subcontracting and 1% AABE subcontracting participation; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive qualified bid in the amount of \$1,058,480.00, from Friesenhahn Paving LLC, for a labor and materials contract for asphalt work in San Antonio parks is hereby accepted. The contract described herein shall become effective upon the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates so long as such deposits are accomplished within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this ordinance. A copy of the contractor's executed Formal Invitation for Bids and Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. The amount up to \$1,058,480.00 will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to Friesenhahn Paving LLC. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2015 and subsequent budgets that fall within the term period of this contract approved by City Council.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.





1. Question: Can you please give an example of a common "scope of work" for concrete construction for this contract? From mobilization to proposal acceptance, to completed work, to invoicing and final payment. This brief description will allow us (bidders) to be sure we know what to expect. It allows everyone to be on same page for bidding.

Response: For example, Concepcion Park had existing parking area that had many potholes and low lying areas. The budget did not allow for complete tear up and rebuilding. The depressed areas were cut, recompacted, re-asphalted then the entire parking area was seal coated.

2. Question: Will barricades and construction fencing be required for each job?

Response: Yes, each job will require barricades and construction fencing.

3. Question: Will a project sign be required for each job?

Response: A project sign may be required for the job. If the repair is more than 2 days, signage is required.

4. Question: Will a SWPPP plan be required for each job?

Response: Since the asphalt is repair, a SWPPP is not required. Only for new construction is a SWPPP required.

5. Question: Will tree protection be required for each job? What standard of protection does the Parks Department require around trees? What about if tree pruning is needed, is that part of our scope also?

Response: Yes, tree protection is required for each job.

6. Question: How does the proposal process work for each job?

Response: The project manager meets the contractor on site and discusses the scope of work. The contractor provides a proposal to the project manager. If acceptable, the proposal is submitted by the project manager for a PO (purchase order), then the work is scheduled to be performed upon receipt of the PO.

7. Question: How does the payment process work for each job?

Response: The payment process will happen through PRIMELink

8. Question: Will each individual job have separate payrolls or is payroll input for a yearly basis for the entire contract.

Response: This contract will be active for three years or until the contract capacity has been reached. The contract capacity will be loaded into SAP and as task orders are issued, lines will be created on the purchase order.

9. Question: Is the one course seal coat treatment a topping rock (pre-coat aggregate) or a slurry seal?
