AN ORDINANCE 2015-04-16-0314

APPOINTING ELAINE MENDOZA (MAYOR), RICHARD MIDDLETON (CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 1), JOSUE "JOE" ROBLES (CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 3), GLORIA RAMIREZ (CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 7) TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO'S EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR TWO YEAR TERMS BEGINNING JUNE 1, 2015 AND ENDING MAY 31, 2017.

WHEREAS, Chapter 379A, Texas Local Government Code (the "Act") authorizes a municipality to create a municipal development corporation to develop and implement programs for early childhood development that prepare each child to enter school and make each child ready to learn after completing the program, that provide educational services to promote literacy, and that establish math, reading, and lifelong learning skills; and

WHEREAS, the City Council (the "City Council") of the City of San Antonio, Texas (the "City") authorized the creation of the San Antonio Early Childhood Education Municipal Development Corporation (the "Corporation") for the purposes of developing early childhood literacy and educational programs in accordance with the Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the City called a sales tax election, held on November 6, 2012, for voter approval to levy a sales and use tax for the benefit of the Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the voters approved the imposition of a 1/8 cent sales tax, and the City Council has passed an ordinance adopting and imposing such tax on December 13, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires the City Council to appoint one director to the Board of Directors for the Corporation from each city council district that elects a member to the City Council, plus the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the initial terms for Board members be staggered so that as near as possible to one-half of the member's terms expire each year, thus requiring that members appointed from odd-numbered districts, as well as the Mayor's appointee, will serve an initial term expiring on May 31, 2015, and members appointed from even-numbered districts served initial terms that expired on May 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, City Council members for odd-numbered districts hereby make their appointments for Board members for the Corporation with terms beginning June 1, 2015 and ending May 31, 2017; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Elaine Mendoza (Mayor), Richard Middleton (District 1), Josue "Joe" Robles (District 3), Gloria Ramirez (District 5), and John M. Folks (District 7) are appointed to the Board of Directors for the City of San Antonio's Early Childhood Education Municipal Development Corporation, for terms of office beginning on June 1, 2015 and expiring on May 31, 2017.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
