AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$650,000.00 TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR A GRANT FROM THE 2015 ENHANCED COLLABORATIVE MODEL TO COMBAT HUMAN TRAFFICKING COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT AND ENHANCEMENT OF A MULTIDISCIPLINARY HUMAN TRAFFICKING COALITION; AUTHORIZING AN INKIND MATCHING CONTRIBUTION OF \$216,667.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE FUNDS, UPON AWARD.

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WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) has grant funds available to the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) in an amount up to \$650,000.00 from the 2015 Enhanced Collaborative Model to Combat Human Trafficking Competitive Solicitation to support the development and enhancement of a multidisciplinary human trafficking coalition; and

WHEREAS, said coalition would develop and implement collaborative approaches to combat all forms of human trafficking; and

WHEREAS, a City in-kind matching contribution of \$216,667.00 is required; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to submit a grant application in an amount not to exceed \$650,000.00 to the DOJ for grant funds from the 2015 Enhanced Collaborative Model to Combat Human Trafficking Competitive Solicitation. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under the same terms and conditions as applied for. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.

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SECTION 2. Should a grant be awarded, upon acceptance, fund and internal order numbers shall be created. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto **Exhibit I**, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
