AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH **GOODWILL** A **SAN INDUSTRIES OF ANTONIO** TO **PROVIDE** LANDSCAPING SERVICES AT VARIOUS CITY LOCATIONS TO INCLUDE MOWING, MULCHING, EDGING, SHRUB PRUNING, TRIMMING, LEAF/DEBRIS BLOWING SWEEPING FOR AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$90,000.00 ANNUALLY, FUNDED WITH THE FY2015 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, the City released a Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP) to provide the City with landscaping services at various city locations; and

WHEREAS, nine responses were received and evaluated; and

WHEREAS, the proposals from Alternative Solutions 316, Cantu Contracting, Inc., and Pro-Landscape Solutions were deemed nonresponsive for failure to meet proposal bond requirements, and the proposal from Pro-Care Landscape Maintenance, LLC was deemed nonresponsive for failure to submit the correct, complete price schedule; and

WHEREAS, five remaining proposals were evaluated and scored; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends Goodwill Industries of San Antonio for award of this contract; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The proposal submitted by Goodwill Industries of San Antonio to provide the City with landscaping services at various city locations is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the score summary and RFCSP are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. A copy of the proposal may be inspected in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

SECTION 2. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2015 and subsequent budgets that fall within the term period of this contract.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
