AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT SAN ANTONIO TO PROVIDE EVALUATION SERVICES FOR THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT'S CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION SODIUM REDUCTION IN COMMUNITIES GRANT IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$52,613.00 FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING AUGUST 1, 2015 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 29, 2016.

WHEREAS, approximately 90% of Americans consume too much sodium, increasing their risk of having high blood pressure; and

WHEREAS, because nearly 400,000 deaths each year are attributed to high blood pressure, decreasing sodium intake could prevent thousands of deaths annually; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Sodium Reduction in Communities grant is to reduce sodium intake to limits recommended by the 2010 U.S. Dietary Guidelines for Americans, US2010, which is a program of research on changes in American society in the recent past, led by project director John Logan, professor of sociology at Brown University; and

WHEREAS, the grant expects to achieve at least two of the following short-term outcomes by the end of the project period: 1) increased availability of lower sodium food products (i.e., presence of lower sodium foods in the environment), 2) increased accessibility of lower sodium food products (i.e., presence of lower sodium foods available in a form, location, price and time that facilitates their consumption) and 3) increased purchase/selection of lower sodium food products; and

WHEREAS, in April 2015, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District in coordination with the Finance Department's Purchasing Division issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for professional consulting services to evaluate program performance of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Sodium Reduction in Communities grant project; and

WHEREAS, the evaluation committee recommended the University of Texas at San Antonio; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or his designee is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the University of

Texas at San Antonio to provide evaluation services for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Sodium Reduction in Communities grant in an amount up to \$52,613.00 for the period beginning August 1, 2015 through September 29, 2016. A copy of the agreement, in substantially final form, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I.**

SECTION 2. The sum of \$52,613.00.00 is hereby appropriated in the designated fund below and will be disbursed from GL 5201040. Payment is authorized to the University of Texas at San Antonio upon issuance of a Purchase Order.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
