Janet Dietel, San Antonio Conservation Society Representative, is concerned with the zoning request due to the architectural significance as a late Victorian style residence with physical feature findings. The home is documented as one of the most architectural significant houses in the Government Hill Neighborhood, and appears on the 1886 bird eye's map of San Antonio, possibly making the property eligible for designation as a local land mark.

<u>Claudia Guerra</u>, Office of Historic Preservation, Cultural Historian, has spoken with the applicant, and explained the process for review in regards to a demolition permit. A thorough research review must be completed in order to recommend approval or denial for the permit.
