A request for a zoning change from "RM-5 AHOD" Residential Mixed Airport Hazard Overlay District to "IDZ AHOD" Infill Development Zone Airport Hazard Overlay District with uses for Fourteen (14) Attached Single-Family Dwelling Units on 0.421 of an acre tract out of NCB A-46 located at 825 East Grayson. Staff recommends Approval.
