AN ORDINANCE 2007-01-11-0054

AMENDING THE RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE SCHEDULING AND CONSIDERATION OF ITEMS AT CITY COUNCIL AND COMMITTEE MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, Sections 11 and 12 of the City Charter authorize the City Council to determine its rules of procedure and order of business; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2003-24-26, passed and approved on June 12, 2003, adopted certain rules and procedures for the scheduling and consideration of items at City Council and Council Committee meetings; and

WHEREAS, this procedure approved in Resolution No. 2003-24-26 directed the use of a "Council Consideration Request" (CCR), a memorandum signed by at least six members of the City Council, to place an item for consideration on the agenda of a City Council or Council Committee meeting; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The procedure for scheduling the consideration of items at City Council and Council Committee meetings is hereby amended to require that the "Council Consideration Request" (CCR) memorandum be signed by exactly five councilmembers.

SECTION 2. The sponsoring Councilmember shall forward the CCR to the Office of the City Clerk, which shall forward a copy to all members of the City Council and the City Manager.

SECTION 3. A CCR that requests consideration of an action to (1) expend District contingency funds; (2) authorize temporary street closure for parades, runs and specials events, or (3) make District board, committee or commission appointments shall be placed on the next available City Council agenda by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. A CCR that requests consideration of an action: (1) to set general, city-wide policy; (2) to make changes in general policy; (3) that may have budgetary or financial impact; or (4) to consider an action that requires substantial staff work or that requires the redeployment of staff and resources from an existing priority, will be placed on the next available agenda to the Council Governance Committee by the City Clerk.

SECTION 5. The Governance Committee shall schedule an item requested by a CCR in a timely manner, considering all policy or other council initiatives in a fair and open manner within council-determined priorities and related constraints. The committee shall neither be used

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to screen policy or other city council initiative nor be used as a way to advance any one issue or agenda over another.

SECTION 6. A City Council member's signature on a CCR means only that the member agrees that the matter should be scheduled for consideration and does not denote the member's position on the matter to be considered.

SECTION 7. The City Council, by a majority vote during a City Council meeting, may direct staff to place an item on the agenda for a future City Council or Council Committee meeting.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall supercede any prior ordinance, resolution, or rule pertaining to the CCR process or other means of placing items on the agenda of the City Council agenda meetings by members of the City Council.

SECTION 9. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight (8) affirmative votes, or in the event eight (8) affirmative votes are not received, on the tenth day after passage.
