ACCEPTING AN OFFER FROM COWBOY DODGE, JEEP, RAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIVE REPLACEMENT DODGE RAM 3500 ONE-TON FIRST RESPONDER UNITS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$256,148.75, FUNDED WITH THE EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Cowboy Dodge, Jeep, Ram, through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (a.k.a. the "Buyboard"), to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with five Dodge Ram 3500 one-ton first responder units for a total cost of \$256,148.75; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 97097 on January 30, 2003; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Cowboy Dodge, Jeep, Ram to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with five Dodge Ram 3500 one-ton first responder units for a total cost of \$256,148.75 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$255,748.75 for this ordinance is available for Fund 72001000, Cost Center 3503200001 and General Ledger 5501055, as part of the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget.

SECTION 3. Funding in the amount of \$400.00 for this ordinance is available for Fund 72001000, Cost Center 3503200001 and General Ledger 5201040, as part of the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget.

SECTION 4. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount of \$256,148.75 is authorized to Cowboy Dodge, Jeep, Ram and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

004 - SPECIFICATIONS / SCOPE OF SERVICES

Scope: The City of San Antonio is soliciting bids to furnish first responder trucks in accordance with the specifications listed herein. These vehicles include pickup trucks which will be utilized by the San Antonio Fire Department.

GENERAL CONDITIONS: The following general conditions will apply to all items within this bid unless specifically excluded within any item.

City of San Antonio reserves the right to increase or decrease quantity of units being purchased up to the production "cut-off" date submitted on the bid for the particular item, depending on availability of funds. Prices may not be increased during this period; however, the City should benefit from any price decrease. Additional units may be purchased on an "as needed" basis. Successful vendor is required to notify the City of all production "cut-off" dates necessary for order submission. Unless otherwise approved by the City, VEHICLES DELIVERED DURING A CALENDAR YEAR MUST BE THE MODEL YEAR VEHICLES FOR THAT CALENDAR YEAR OR NEWER. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL VENDOR DELIVER MODEL YEAR VEHICLES FOR THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR.

All components shall be installed new, unused, standard production model, and equipment is to be serviced in accordance with manufacturer's recommended pre-delivery check list, and ready for operation upon delivery, and shall include all manufacturers' standard equipment unless otherwise specified or replaced therein. Equipment offered under the below listed specifications will be considered unacceptable if for any reason its long term availability on the U.S. Market or in the local area is in doubt.

Equipment must include the maximum standard manufacturer's warranty on all components, with parts and service included. All components, parts and service shall include, as a minimum, a one year unlimited mileage/hours warranty. All warranty times shall start the date the vehicle is placed in service as determined by the City, not on the delivery date. The dealer will be notified by letter of the in-service date of each vehicle by serial number. Bidder shall fully explain the warranty by attaching separate, authenticated correspondence or entering such information in the remarks section of this bid. Warranty, reliability, and replacement captive parts costs and availability shall be a consideration in award of this bid. Warranty parts and service must be available within 50 mile radius of San Antonio City Hall from and by a factory-authorized dealer (NO EXCEPTIONS). In the event that a unit purchased from a vendor requires transportation outside of Bexar County for a repair covered under warranty repair facility. If the vendor chooses to travel to inspect the unit to determine if the repair needed is covered under warranty, all expenses shall be paid for by the vendor. All warranty repairs must be completed within three (3) business days from the date equipment is delivered to the vendor unless otherwise approved by the appropriate City of San Antonio BESD Fleet Operations Manager or designate. Bidders must certify that all repairs needed after the warranty period will be available within 50 mile radius of San Antonio City Hall.

All deliveries must be pre-arranged with a minimum 24-hour notification, NO EXCEPTIONS. Vehicles will not be accepted after 4:00 P.M. CST. Vehicles with more than 100 miles accumulated on the odometer will not be accepted. All vehicles are required to have a full tank(s) of fuel and a full tank of Diesel Exhaust Fluid, if equipped, when delivered to City specified location.

Equipment Manuals – Each delivered unit must contain an operator's manual NO EXCEPTIONS. A manufacture's parts and maintenance manual or CD ROM must be delivered to the City of San Antonio Fleet Acquisitions at the vendor's cost per model of all equipment, accessories, and components, NO EXCEPTIONS.

All prices will be quoted F.O.B., designated City facility, freight prepaid. All bids will be submitted in triplicate and will include complete manufacturer's specifications for each model being bid.

The Manufacturer's Statement of Origin (MSO), Dealer Temporary license plates/tags, proper Invoice, signed 130U form and State Weight Certificate/slip (for trucks over one ton) are required upon delivery of each unit and are required before payment can be processed. Any of these missing items will delay the payment process.

All units to be equipped at the factory with air conditioning, full headliner, fresh air heater and defroster units, minimum AM/FM OEM radio, power windows and power door locks and manual tilt steering wheel. All units to be equipped with steering column mounted gear selector unless otherwise specified. Each unit shall have a minimum two keyless remotes (fobs) and shall have a minimum of three (3) sets of keys.

All bodies and components in this bid will be installed in accordance with the appropriate Incomplete Vehicle Data Manual. Certification of compliance will be posted on the left door post of the vehicle. Except for manufacturer's data plates (maximum 4" x 6"), vendor or manufacturer's identifying markings (decals and plates) will not be applied to the vehicle or mounted components. Installation will be completed in compliance with Federal Motor Vehicle Department of Transportation Standards and Texas State Highway requirements. Installation of body and accessories on City furnished vehicles will be accomplished by drilling holes in the frame. Welding on or cutting of frame is **not** authorized forward of the rear spring hanger or support. Bidders will be responsible for the relocation of any truck components to facilitate installation of the body and equipment. Such relocation must be included as part of the basic bid.

All units to have vinyl type seating where available and floor shall be rubber or vinyl material as well.

All units to be equipped with safety equipment as required by the Federal Government.

All accessories and equipment will be OEM. The manufacturer will rate all equipment provided as low emission on all models available.

Fuel systems to be diesel, and a minimum 25 gallon capacity unless otherwise specified. All diesel engine applications are to be of the lowest emission/clean fuel; (Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel) offered by manufacturer and must meet 2010 diesel emission standards set by EPA. Maximum capacity cooling system offered by manufacturer.

Electrical – Heavy duty battery and alternator offered by manufacturer for models being bid. All units to be equipped with oil pressure, water temperature, and volt or amp gauges.

Spare tires required by the below listed specifications must be identical in manufacturer's tread design, ply rating (load range) etc., as those furnished on driving and steering axles. Tires still under evaluation will not be acceptable.

Vehicles to be equipped with OEM tinted glass and current State Inspection Sticker.

All vehicles exteriors to be painted O.E.M. white unless otherwise specified.

Unless otherwise specified under individual items, vehicles provided will have a minimum of a driver's seat and one passenger seat.

All trucks and vans, unless otherwise specified are to be equipped with rubber or vinyl flooring.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive irregularities and any requirements of the bid if deemed to be in the best interest of the City.

All pickup trucks shall be provided with limited slip axles.

Tow package to include receiver hitch with OEM in-cab mounted trailer brake controller and both a 4-Way flat vehicle connector and 7-Way round vehicle connector (Flat Pin) to be provided on all trucks.

No dealership nameplates, markings or decals will be permitted on the vehicles.

BRAND NAMES:

Manufacturer names, trade names, brand names, and product numbers used herein are for the purpose of describing and establishing tested, compatible, approved and acceptable products that are of the type and quality required by the City. The use of pre-approved brand names are not intended to limit competition; therefore the phrase "or equal" is added. For purposes of this contract, the proposed "or equal" products shall require close adherence to the established standards of performance and quality inherently derived and reasonably expected from the brand named products specified herein. The City shall be the sole judge of equality and suitability.

- 1. ENGINE: 6.7 Liter Inline 6 Cylinder Cummins Turbo Diesel Engine
- 2. GVWR: Minimum 11,400 lbs.
- 3. TRANSMISSION/DRIVE: Automatic with overdrive; 5 speed minimum; Power Steering. 4x2 design.
- 4. SUSPENSION: Heaviest Duty available to include heavy duty shock absorbers, independent struts with stabilization.
- 5. **DIMENSIONS:** Four Full Door cab configuration. 5.1.1.Pick-up box length shall be a minimum of 75" inches.
 - 5.1.2. Wheelbase to be a minimum of 167" inches.
- 6. BRAKES: Equipped with 4-wheel automatic braking system, and front vented discs minimum.
- 7. TIRES & WHEELS: Tires to meet or exceed minimum gross vehicle weight rating of vehicle, manufacturer recommended tire size for application specified. Maximum traction tread design with full size matching spare tire and wheel.
- 8. FUEL SYSTEM: Fuel tank shall hold a minimum of 25 gallons of Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel.
- 9. **SEATING:** Vinyl seating and upholstery. Front seating to be 40/20/40 split with center section removed and rear to be bench seating.
- 10. BUMPER /HITCH: Unit to be equipped with a type 4/5 trailer hitch with 7 way trailer light connector.
- 11. MIRRORS: OEM standard type inside. Power mirrors outside, left and right, collapsible, below eye level type. Recreational swing or telescoping type. Largest size available in model offered. Remote controlled from driver.
- 12. Rear View Back Up Camera: Truck should come equipped with prewired rear view backup camera prewired to rear view mirror or acceptable lcd screen viewable from the driver seat.

Veteran-Owned Small Business Program Tracking Form

Authority. San Antonio City Code Chapter 2, Article XI describes the City's veteran-owned small business preference program.

Tracking. <u>This solicitation is not eligible for a preference</u> based on status as a veteran-owned small business (VOSB). Nevertheless, in order to determine whether the program can be expanded at a later date, the City tracks VOSB participation at both prime contract and subcontract levels.

Certification. The City relies on inclusion in the database of veteran-owned small businesses (VOSB) maintained by the U.S. Small Business Administration to verify VOSB status; however, veteran status may also be confirmed by certification by another public or private entity that uses similar certification procedures.

Definitions.

The program uses the federal definitions of veteran and veteran-owned small business found in 38 CFR Part 74.

- The term "veteran" means a person who served on active duty with the U.S. Army, Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, for any length of time and at any place and who was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable. Reservists or members of the National Guard called to federal active duty or disabled from a disease or injury incurred or aggravated in line of duty or while in training status.
- A veteran-owned small business is a business that is not less than 51 percent owned by one or more veterans, or in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than 51 percent of the stock of which is owned by one or more veterans; the management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more veterans and qualifies as "small" for Federal business size stand purposes.

The program uses the below definition of joint venture.

Joint Venture means a collaboration of for-profit business entities, in response to a solicitation, which
is manifested by a written agreement, between two or more independently owned and controlled
business firms to form a third business entity solely for purposes of undertaking distinct roles and
responsibilities in the completion of a given contract. Under this business arrangement, each joint
venture partner shares in the management of the joint venture and also shares in the profits or
losses of the joint venture enterprise commensurately with its contribution to the venture.

The program does not distinguish between a veteran and a service-disabled veteran-owned business and is not limited geographically.

Local Preference Program Identification Form

The City of San Antonio Local Preference Program, described in the San Antonio City Code Chapter 2, Article XII, establishes a local preference for specific contracting categories. Each time a bidder or respondent submits a bid for a solicitation, this Local Preference Program Identification Form must be completed and turned in with the solicitation response in order to be identified as a City Business and receive the preference described below. The City will not rely on Local Preference Program Identification Forms submitted with prior or contemporaneous bids or proposals.

The Local Preference Program allows the City to grant a preference to a business meeting the definition of *City Business* in the award of the following types of contracts, when selection is made based on price alone:

- <u>Personal Property (Goods / Supplies)</u>: The local bidder's price must be within 3% of the price of the lowest non-local bidder for contracts of \$50,000 or more;
- <u>Non-professional Services</u>: The local bidder's price must be within 3% of the price of the lowest nonlocal bidder for contracts of \$50,000 to under \$500,000;
- <u>Construction Services</u>: The local bidder's price must be within 3% of the price of the lowest non-local bidder for contracts of \$50,000 to under \$100,000, excluding contracts awarded using alternative delivery methods.

The Local Preference Program also allows the award of additional points, when multiple evaluation criteria are used in the award of professional service contracts, where the selection process is not governed by statute and in revenue generating and concession contracts. A business meeting the definition of *City Business* stated below may be awarded 10 points for being headquartered within the city, or 5 points for having a local office within the city.

Moreover, the program recognizes joint venture agreements and allows for apportioning of points based upon the percentage of ownership of joint ventures by *City Businesses* responding to solicitations for which discretionary points are applied. For solicitations where selection is made based on price alone, all members of a joint venture must be *City Businesses* for the preference to be applied.

<u>City Business</u> is defined as a business headquartered within the incorporated San Antonio city limits for one year or more OR one that meets the following conditions:

- Has an established place of business for one year or more in the incorporated limits of the City:
- (a) from which at least 100 of its employees OR at least 20% of its total full-time, part-time and contract employees are regularly based; and
- (b) from which a substantial role in the business' performance of a commercially useful function or a substantial part of its operations is conducted by those employees.

A location utilized solely as a post office box, mail drop or telephone message center or any similar combination, with no other substantial work function, is not a *City Business*.

For the purposes of this program, Headquartered is defined as the place where a business entity's officers direct, control, and coordinate the entity's activities.

NOTE: Bidders / Respondents are required to submit documentation to substantiate that the requirements of a City Business have been met. Examples of documentation may include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Existence of local headquarters or office: For corporations, Texas Comptroller's listing of names/addresses of officers and directors. For partnerships, partnership agreement and any documents identifying the current managing partners and their current work addresses
- 2. Evidence of local headquarters or office in existence for one year or more: Utility bills, real property lease agreements, equipment leases, personal property taxes, real property taxes
- 3. Evidence of number of employees: Organizational charts, payroll records by location
