**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$1,523,000.00: (A) FARRWEST ENVIRONMENTAL FOR HAZMAT SUITS FOR THE SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT, (B) MODERN EDGE, LLC D/B/A AUTOMOTIVE DISCOUNT SPECIALISTS FOR AUTOMOBILE & LIGHT DUTY TRUCK WINDOW TINTING SERVICES, (C) RED MCCOMBS MOTORS, LTD. FOR TOYOTA AUTOMOTIVE PARTS & SERVICES, (D) TRASTAR INC. FOR ILLUMINATED STREET SIGNS, (E) ALM HOLDINGS CORPORATION FOR SPANISH LANGUAGE PRINT & MEDIA MATERIALS, (F) JOHNSON CONTROLS, INC. FOR CSF METASYS FACILITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, (G) GRANDE TRUCK CENTER FOR AUTOCAR TRUCK PARTS & SERVICE, (H) DOGETT FREIGHTLINER OF SOUTH TEXAS FOR CONDOR TRUCK PARTS & SERVICE, (I) SELRICO SERVICES, INC. FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE CUSTODIAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR SAN ANTONIO BRANCH LIBRARIES TO ADD A FACILITY, (J) DUNBAR ARMORED INC. FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARMORED CAR SERVICES CONTRACT TO ADD THREE FACILITIES, AND (K) 3RD GENERATION SERVICES, LLC D/B/A CEILING PRO OF SAN ANTONIO FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE CUSTODIAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR VARIOUS CITY FACILITIES TO ADD NINE FACILITIES.**

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**WHEREAS**, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

**WHEREAS**, these bids are from the following companies to furnish the City with: (A) FarrWest Environmental for hazmat suits for the San Antonio Fire Department, (B) Modern Edge, LLC d/b/a Automotive Discount Specialists for automobile & light duty truck window tinting services, (C) Red McCombs Motors, Ltd. for Toyota automotive parts & services, (D) TraStar Inc. for illuminated street signs, (E) Alm Holdings Corporation for Spanish language print & media materials, (F) Johnson Controls, Inc. for CSF Metasys Facility Management System, (G) Grande Truck Center for Autocar truck parts & service, (H) Doggett Freightliner of South Texas for Condor truck parts & service, (I) Selrico Services, Inc. for an amendment to the custodial services contract for San Antonio branch libraries to add a facility, (J) Dunbar Armored Inc. for an amendment to the armored car services contract to add three facilities, and (K) 3rd Generation Services, LLC d/b/a Ceiling Pro of San Antonio for an amendment to the custodial services contract for various city facilities to add nine facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance approves three low bid contracts, one contract awarded to other than the low bidder(s) because the low bidder(s) did not meet the City's specifications or requirements, one contract which provides for a procurement necessary to protect the public

health or safety, three sole source contracts, and amendments to three previously awarded contracts; and

**WHEREAS**, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE**:

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The bids of the following companies to furnish the City with: (A) FarrWest Environmental for hazmat suits for the San Antonio Fire Department, (B) Modern Edge, LLC d/b/a Automotive Discount Specialists for automobile & light duty truck window tinting services, (C) Red McCombs Motors, Ltd. for Toyota automotive parts & services, (D) TraStar Inc. for illuminated street signs, (E) Alm Holdings Corporation for Spanish language print & media materials, (F) Johnson Controls, Inc. for CSF Metasys Facility Management System, (G) Grande Truck Center for Autocar truck parts & service, (H) Doggett Freightliner of South Texas for Condor truck parts & service, (I) Selrico Services, Inc. for an amendment to the custodial services contract for San Antonio branch libraries to add a facility, (J) Dunbar Armored Inc. for an amendment to the armored car services contract to add three facilities, and (K) 3rd Generation Services, LLC d/b/a Ceiling Pro of San Antonio for an amendment to the custodial services contract for various city facilities to add nine facilities on an annual contract basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets, are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

**SECTION 2.** The amounts will be encumbered upon issuance of various purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All current fiscal year expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2016 budget approved by City Council, and future fiscal year expenditures are contingent upon future City council budget approvals.

**SECTION 3.** It has been found and declared that the low bid from Brown Traffic Products, Inc. for illuminated street signs failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
