

AN ORDINANCE 2015-10-01-0844

**AUTHORIZING THREE-MONTH EXTENSIONS TO THE
EMS MEDICAL CONTROL AND TRAINING
AGREEMENT AND THE EMS MEDICAL DIRECTION
AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO WITH THE UNIVERSITY
OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER AT SAN
ANTONIO IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$503,311.79.**

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio (City) and the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio (Center), pursuant to Ordinance 2011-08-18-0677, entered into the EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties, pursuant to Ordinance 2013-06-20-0475, extended said agreement through September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Center, pursuant to Ordinance 2011-08-18-0678, entered into the EMS Medical Direction Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties, pursuant to Ordinance 2013-06-20-0476, extended said agreement through September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Center now wish to extend both agreements through December 31, 2015, and provide for funding for the period of the extensions; and

WHEREAS, extensions of these agreements will cost the City an amount that does not exceed \$503,311.79; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

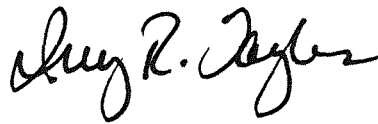
SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to execute the Second Extension of and Third Amendment to the EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit I** and the Second Extension of and Third Amendment to the EMS Medical Direction Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit II**. The terms of these agreements are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Funding for this Ordinance in the amount of \$503,311.79 is available as part of the Fiscal Year 2016 budget in Fund 11001000, Cost Center 2015050002, and General Ledger 5201040. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to the Center and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.

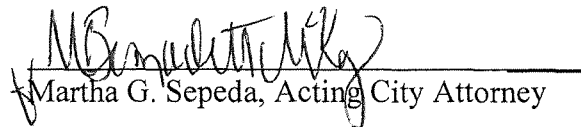

SECOND EXTENSION OF AND THIRD AMENDMENT TO EMS MEDICAL CONTROL AND TRAINING AGREEMENT

This Second Extension of and Third Amendment to EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement is entered into pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Tex. Gov. Code §791.011 et. seq. by and between the City of San Antonio (CITY), a Texas municipal corporation, acting through its City Manager, and the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio (CENTER).

WHEREAS, CITY and CENTER, pursuant to Ordinance 2011-08-18-0677, entered into the EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Subsection F(1) of that agreement provides for an initial term of two years, from October 1, 2011, to September 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Subsection F(1) of the agreement also provides for an extension of two years, from October 1, 2013, to September 30, 2015, should the parties desire such; and

WHEREAS, the parties chose to extend the agreement until September 30, 2015, and, pursuant to Ordinance 2013-06-20-0475, did so by way of the Extension of and Second Amendment to EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to extend the agreement to December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the agreement to provide for this extension, to extend the agreement, and to modify pricing for the period of the extension; **NOW THEREFORE**:

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Subsection F(1) of the EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement is hereby amended to provide as follows:

The term of this Agreement shall begin on October 1, 2011 and end on September 30, 2013. This Agreement may be extended by mutual agreement of the parties on the same terms and conditions, except for price, for up to one two-year renewal period, by written agreement, signed by both parties and authorized by the San Antonio City Council by passage of an ordinance. This Agreement may be extended by mutual agreement of the parties on the same terms and conditions, except for price, for the period October 1, 2015, to December 31, 2015, by written agreement, signed by both parties and authorized by the San Antonio City Council by passage of an ordinance.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Subsection F(1) of the EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement, said agreement is hereby extended for the period beginning October 1, 2015, and ending December 31, 2015.

Exhibit I

SECTION 3. Subsection D(6) of the EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Tuition and Fees for October 1, 2011 – December 31, 2015. As per the Texas Education Code, there will be no tuition or lab fees charged for EMT-Basic & EMT-Paramedic initial education.

SECTION 4. The EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement is hereby amended to add Subsection G(1B), which shall provide as follows:

In consideration for the services provided and purchases made pursuant to the terms of this contract, the CITY agrees to pay the CENTER \$332,318.51 for the period October 1, 2015, to December 31, 2015 in accordance with the provisions of this section, and in conformance with Exhibit III – Budget, which is incorporated herein for all purposes. Payment will be billed on October 1, 2015.

SECTION 5. All other terms, conditions, covenants, and provisions of the EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement not specifically mentioned herein and revised by this document, are hereby retained in their entirety, unchanged, and shall remain in full force in effect for the duration of said agreement, and any renewals thereof.


SECTION 6. This Second Extension of and Third Amendment to EMS Medical Control and Training Agreement embodies the complete agreement of the parties hereto with regard to the subject matter contained herein, superseding all oral or written previous and contemporary agreements between the parties relating to matters herein.
