Issue Proposed for Consideration

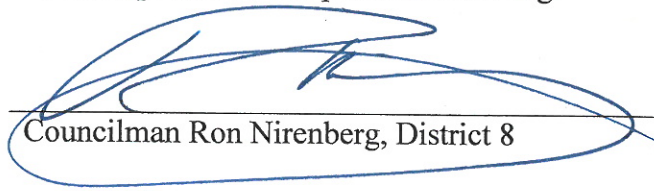
I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda of the earliest City Council meeting:

Brief Background

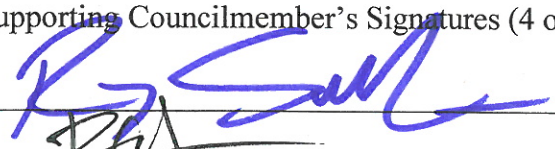
The United States Department of the Treasury has announced the auction of approximately 33 acres of seized and forfeited real property located at 6451 Babcock on January 21, 2016. The acreage is currently undeveloped and is one of the last large parcels of property in District 8 and a more deliberative consideration to the appropriate zoning is called for. This resolution would provide timely notice to interested parties of this potential rezoning.
